- RX = X stroke roll
- PD = Paradiddle
- 2PD = Double Paradiddle
- 3PD = Triple Paradiddle

Every odd roll has two forms, even rolls have a third form:

1. accent(s) at the beginning
2. accent(s) at the end
3. accent at begin **and** end

You should combine more than two rudiments as well.

Repeat the parts of the combinations with different lengths.
